In the Carnduff and District Festival, in order to qualify for an award in SOLO VOICE classes or SOLO SPEECH ART classes, a competitor must enter and compete in two classes from disciplines # 1, #2, #3, or #10. Also, the competitor must reside in our border to border area, namely Alameda, Lampman, Alida, Storthoaks, Gainsborough and Carnduff. Winners of all scholarships and awards are chosen by the adjudicators. Some awards or scholarships may not be given.
