## SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

To qualify for a trophy and most scholarships, solo competitors must be under 19 years of age and must achieve a mark of 85 or more. In most cases, competitors must have performed in at least two solo classes in the same discipline, one of which must be a test piece or a piece of provincial or national status. Exceptions to this rule regarding the test piece requirement are students in the First Year of Instruction classes, those under 7 years of age and some open scholarships. The adjudicator's decision regarding scholarships will be final. Please refer to the local program for a complete listing of scholarships and awards.
